

YESTERDAY 22 VETERANS WERE LOST TO SUICIDE

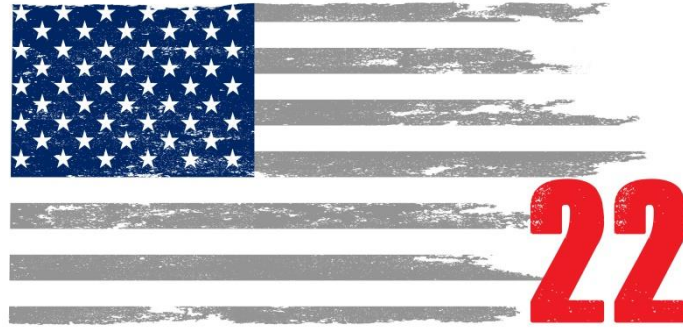
That makes the war at home more dangerous than all of our combat missions around the world. End the stigma surrounding Post Traumatic Stress Disorder. End the silence.

WHAT

22 MEN AND WOMEN WILL MARCH 22 KILOMETERS CARRYING STANDARD MILITARY RUCKSACKS EACH WEIGHING 22 POUNDS ON 22 OCTOBER, 2017.

WHO

MARCH FOR THE 22 IS A COMBINED EFFORT ON THE PART OF ACTIVE DUTY MILITARY, VETERANS, COMMUNITY LEADERS AND CITIZENS OF BUCKS COUNTY.

WHERE

THE MARCH WILL BEGIN AT THE NATIONAL CEMETERY IN WASHINGTON'S CROSSING AND WILL CULMINATE IN THE COURTYARD OF THE FORMER COUNTY COURTHOUSE @ COURT AND MAIN STREETS - DOYLESTOWN
